ACT

To amend the Provincial Tender Board Act, 1994 (Act No. 2 of 1994), to provide for the extension of the terms of office of members of the Board; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the Gauteng Provincial Legislature, as follows:—

Insertion of section 4A in Act No. 2 of 1994

1. The following section is inserted in the Provincial Tender Board Act, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act") after section 4: 5

"4A. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4(7), the responsible Member may, when circumstances warrant an extension rather than a new appointment after a second consecutive term, extend the term of office of a member of the Board by notice in the Provincial Gazette: Provided that —

- (a) only one extension in relation to a particular member is allowed;
- (b) no extension may exceed 18 (*eighteen*) months calculated from the end of the current term of the member in question; and
- (c) no additional remuneration and allowances other than those to which a member appointed under subsection 4(4) is entitled, is payable".

Short title and commencement 15

2. This Act is called the Provincial Tender Board Amendment Act, 2001, and shall be regarded to have taken effect on 30 April 2001.
